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The process of formation of leadership qualities in young pedagogues organization and analysis from a scientific and theoretical point of view.

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Abstract. This article analyzes the theoretical-methodical foundations of the development of leadership qualities in young pedagogues, the psychological-pedagogical mechanisms of the process, and the level of organization of this issue in local and foreign literature. Also, the factors, conditions and effective methods of development of leadership competencies in the pedagogical training system are highlighted.

Today's modern education system requires a young teacher not only to be a knowledge holder, but also to be a leader, an all-round initiator, and possess innovative knowledge. Formation of leadership qualities in young pedagogues is one of the important factors of strengthening their professional competence, managing the educational process, gaining influence on the team and increasing personal responsibility. The organization of the concept of leadership in pedagogical sciences has been active since the second half of the 20th century, and now there are many local and foreign studies in this direction.

1. Scientific and theoretical foundations of the concept of leadership

Leadership is the ability to direct a group or a certain team towards a goal, influence, initiative and responsibility. In psychological literature, leadership is explained through the following aspects:

- Communicative potential of the person
- Affective and motivational activity
- The process of social interaction
- A combination of key and acquired qualities.

Khojayeva organized the technologies of developing initiative and creativity in young teachers in their scientific works.

Mentoring: Practice led by mentors.
